OWS Meet Details

Eligibility

This swim meet is open to all registered Masters Swimming Australia (MSA) swimmers, guest swimmers and junior swimmers 14-18 years of age. No late entries will be accepted and no entries on the day. Age as at 31 December 2021.

Entries

Entries are to be submitted via <u>Quick Entry</u> located on the MSQ website. Please register an account and log in prior to completing your entry. Entries will open in late April and close on 8 May 2022. For any problems with entries, please email the <u>Director of Recording</u>.

* Note: Entries capped at 60 swimmers.

Entry fees

Swimmers may enter only one event. All entrants must pay the nomination fee for individual events online as directed by Quick Entry. This fee includes a swim cap, insurance and fruit.

Swimwear

No wetsuits, no zips in swimwear and no flotation devices as per the Masters Swimming Swimwear and Open Water Swimming rules. Please refer to MSA Swimwear Rules.

Watches/Timing Devices

No watches, timing or pacing devices of any description are permitted as per the MSA OWS rules.

Timeline

The 3.8km swim must be completed within 2 hours 20 minutes.

The 1.9km swim must be completed within 1 hour and 10 minutes.

All swimmers are to have completed their swim and exited the water by 10:50am.

Swim Waiver

Each swimmer must sign a 'swim waiver' on the day. Junior swimmers require a parent or guardian signature also.

Rules

All <u>Masters Swimming Australia OWS Rules</u> and FINA Swimming rules apply. By nominating to participate in this swim meet, all swimmers thereby authorise the Meet Director/MSQ Officials to take whatever action is deemed necessary in the event of an emergency, and persons involved accept responsibility for any and all costs arising from such action.

Late entries

No late entries will be accepted. No entries on the day.

Multi Class events

Multi Class swimmer are always welcome, however there will be no separate Multi Class events conducted at this meet.

Results

Results will be posted on the MSQ website within 3-4 days, in addition to the MSQ and masters swimming nq Facebook and Instagram pages.

First Aid/Safety

First aid provisions will be available and water safety will patrol the swim course along with a powered IRB equipped with a Jason's Cradle.

Emergency Evacuation

In case of an emergency, swimmers, officials and safety personnel will be directed to exit the water and go to the appropriate assembly point and await instructions. If asked to evacuate, please do so immediately.

Records

As this is an open water swim no records are available.

Photo/video release

All attendees at this meet agree that they may be photographed or videoed, and that the material may be used by MSQ at their discretion, or by others to promote activities of a club or branch, or for personal use including social media.

Swim course

The swim courses will be available on the event page of the MSQ website on Monday 9 May 2022.

Swim Start

All swimmers will be required to meet at the water entry point for their allocated distance five minutes prior to their start time. Swimmers are not to enter the water until advised by MSQ Technical Director and Chief Official, John Barrett. Swimmers and Officials are to be physically distanced. People who are not swimming or officiating should not be near the starting/finishing area. Events to be marshaled will be announced.

Other information

- Domestic animals are NOT permitted in Crater Lakes National Park.
- Camping is NOT permitted in Crater Lakes National Park.
- Lake Barrine Teahouse is licensed no BYO alcohol.
- Swimmers must be completely dry before entering the teahouse for the safety of all patrons on the day.
- Parking will be available in the top car park, please follow signage. Please be mindful of day visitors to Lake Barrine.
- Lake Barrine Tea House will be open from 8:00am
- MSQ will continually reassess meet details due to the evolving COVID-19 situation to ensure that swimmers' well-being is the highest priority.
- MSQ notes that the information provided is correct at the time of publishing, however, is subject to change.

Getting to Lake Barrine from Cairns

Lake Barrine is about 60 km or 1 hour's drive from Cairns via the Gillies Highway. Approximately 5 minutes after reaching the top of the Gillies Highway, turn left at the "Lake Barrine National Park" sign.

Getting to Lake Barrine from Atherton

Lake Barrine is about 22 km or 20 minutes from Atherton via the Gordonvale Atherton Road. Approximately 8km past Yungaburra, the turnoff to Lake Barrine National Park is on your right.

Please allow extra travelling time if the roads are wet.
